## **Objective of the course**

At the end of the module, the participant is able to understand and to explain the functioning of a watch simple (skeleton).

## Target public

Anyone interested to discover the functioning of a simple watch, a minimum age 14 years.

## **Description of the course**

The course allows to get acquainted with the watch-making world and to discover the technical terms used in watch-making. It includes:

- Dismantling and assembly of a mechanical movement made by a professional
- Panorama of the various components of a watch
- Technical information connected to the watch-making
- Understanding and functioning of a mechanical watch
