





# Discovery and assembly of your own skeleton watch (T19.2)

# Objective of the course

At the end of the module, the participant is able to understand and explain the functioning of a watch simple (skeleton).

#### **Target public**

Anyone interested to discover the watch-making world

## **Prerequire**

You must have participated in the course Initiation (T19.1 module "initiation")

## **Description of the course**

The course allows to get acquainted with the watch-making world and to discover the technical terms used in watch-making. It includes:

- Dismantling and assembly of a mechanical movement made by a professional
- Panorama of the various components of a watch
- Technical information connected to the watch-making
- Understanding and functioning of a mechanical watch
- Assembly of a mechanical watch which the participant will take at the end of the course
